



## Hello kantele-player!

It's time to register for the Ilomantsi kantele-camp 2010. Here is some information about the camp.

### Camp-place

Ilomantsi kantele-camps 2010 take place at the Pogosta School premises near the center of Ilomantsi. **The Camp Major** takes place from the 11<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> of June and **The Camp Minor** from the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> of June.

### Lessons and practice

Every camper has a private kantele-lesson that lasts for 30 minutes. For extra charge it is possible to have a longer kantele-lesson that lasts for 45 minutes. You have lessons every day. Practicing for the lessons happens during free time. Usually a camper should have her/his own instrument with her/him (also a side-instrument). But if it isn't possible to take one's own instrument from abroad we try to arrange instruments for you here. The camp will provide the electric instruments.

### Group-lessons

Group-lessons are the main instrument group, the 1<sup>st</sup> side-instrument group and theory studies. Furthermore a camper can choose traditional singing and folkmusic-knowledge. All these studies are included in the basic teaching charge.

You can also participate in the instrument building and some other side-instrument groups. (see the registration form!).

### Solo side-instrument

You can also have solo side-instrument lessons for extra charge. You can choose from different kanteles, traditional singing, percussions and jouhikko. The solo side-instrument lessons last for 30 minutes a day.

### Instrument building

Instrument building takes place in the camp area where you can build for example little kanteles, drums and kantele-tables. Wishes will be taken into consideration as much as possible. ### Evening program

As well as concerts there will be one "fun-evening" in the kantele-camp's evening program. Furthermore the freetime leaders organize something to do during extra freetime.

### Accommodation

Accommodation takes place basically in classrooms for younger people and adults can have accommodation in rooms for 2 – 3 persons in dormitory-building (this costs a little more than classroom-accommodation). You will need the sheets and pillow case or sleeping bag on your own.
